PCI DSS (Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard) is a set of security standards designed to ensure that all companies that accept credit cards maintain a secure environment.



Why is it important?



Protect Customer Data: A study found that 75% of small businesses could not continue operating if they were hit with ransomware. PCI compliance helps reduce the risk of data breaches and identity theft.



Build Trust: Demonstrating PCI compliance enhances your customers' trust.



Avoid Penalties: Non-compliance may result in fines, legal consequences, and damage to your reputation, and even losing the ability to accept credit cards entirely.
